PUPPY TRAINING CLASSES

KPT - KINDERGARTEN PUPPY

Developmental training courses designed for the 2 - 6 month old puppy. Choose to introduce your puppy to basic manners or opt to extend your training, and begin more extensive work and play with your puppy. 45-55 minute sessions.

OPTION 1: 4 WEEKS - Basic puppy manners training and socialization

OPTION 2: 8 WEEKS - Expand basic puppy manners training; introduction to early obedience training, growth, nutrition, problem solving and puppy games.

FOR ALL KPT TRAINING CLASSES

No Pre-Registration....REGISTER the first night. BRING YOUR PUPPIES, a buckle collar, their favorite soft treats FOR THE FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS.

Required for Registration: You must BRING PROOF of current DHLPP/Parvo vaccinations and a CURRENT rabies certificate (puppies under 4 mos. of age are NOT required to present rabies certificate) and a negative stool check.

KPT (Kindergarten Puppy Training)

Registration: 6:30 pm

THE TIME LISTED ABOVE IS FOR THE NIGHT OF REGISTRATION ONLY, VARYING CLASS TIMES AVAILABLE AT REGISTRATION.

OPTION 1 - First four weeks on schedule

OPTION 2 - BOTH four weeks on schedule = 8 weeks

ADULT DOG TRAINING CLASSES

BEGINNERS

A class for dogs 6 months of age and older, aimed at training you to train your dog. Emphasis is on the training needed to make the dog a good companion: walk on a loose leash, sit, stand, down, stay and come when called. One hr. class sessions - 6 weeks.

INTERMEDIATE

A class for those persons interested in extending the basic training methods with emphasis on dog obedience, foundation of heeling, and the AKC - Canine Good Citizen testing (CGC). Dog's attention, position and response, along with consistency from the handler are the foundation needed for other dog/handler activities. One hr. class sessions - 6 weeks. Prerequisite: Beginners

ADVANCED

A class designed to extend Intermediate level methods and skills and to prepare handlers and their dogs for competitive events, including Rally. One hr. class sessions - 6 weeks. Prerequisite: Intermediate

FOR ALL ADULT DOG TRAINING CLASSES

Class size may be limited.

Required for Registration:

All dogs REGISTERING FOR ADULT CLASSES must BRING PROOF of current DHLPP/Parvo vaccinations and a CURRENT rabies certificate.

REMINDER...

DO NOT BRING YOUR DOGS ON REGISTRATION NIGHT. (Tuesday a.m. classes - bring your dog on the first day!)
