DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months and over that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained AN AKC, ILP OR PAL NUMBER, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Breeds not registerable with the AKC are not eligible to enter. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

The Regulations for Agility Trials are available from the AKC at 5580 Centerview Drive, Raleigh, NC 27606.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTRIES

LIMITED TRIAL ENTRIES

(as per Chapter 1, Section 15; Rules and Regulations, effective April, 2006)

For limited trials, entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Envelopes containing entries of more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must include postage or be metered; be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL (Effectively disallows conventional "hand-deliveries:" during the first 24 hours the trial is open.) No hand-deliveries will be accepted.

The Club will NOT offer refunds for duplicate entries for the same day.

24" WEAVES WILL BE USED IN BOTH RINGS.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

- Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

RIBBONS will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height, in each titling class.

QUALIFYING RIBBONS will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each jump height, in each titling class.

The Club reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial - none will be mailed.

SCHEDULE • CONFIRMATION LETTER

FAST CLASSES WILL FOLLOW STANDARD AND JWW IN EACH RING. The running order will be announced in the confirmation letter. Measurement times, judges' briefings, walk-throughs and ring start times will be outlined; based on entries. Judges will determine the need for split walk-throughs. Exhibitors should verify their entries. Incomplete or incorrect entries will be returned to exhibitors. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for insufficient checks.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- These trials will be held in TWO fully enclosed arenas, rolled packed dirt. STD (to inc. NOVICE FAST) ring - 90 x 90, JWW ring (to inc. OPEN & EXCELLENT FAST) - 80 x 100
- Electronic timing will be used for both rings, all three days.
- 24" weaves poles will be used in both rings, all three days.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. Please note, due to small trial entry limits, entry fees for bitches that come into season after the closing date will be NOT BE REFUNDED.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- There will be a \$25.00 charge for any returned checks.
- \$1.00 per entry applied for admission. One admission per dog entered. General admission fee for non-participants is \$1.00 per day.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- NO CAMPING AND/OR OVERNIGHT PARKING IS PERMITTED AT THE TRIAL SITE.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time MUST enter the Novice level in both Preferred Standard and Preferred JWW regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes. Owners/dogs are allowed to switch back and forth between the Preferred and Regular Classes - BUT NOT AT THE SAME SET OF TRIALS!
Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial, and will be returned.

Jump Height Cards - New Rules effective 1/1/10

All dogs competing in agility must POSSESS an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs except those jumping 24" or 26" (unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present) without permanent or temporary height cards must be measured.

You are NOT REQUIRED to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You ARE REQUIRED to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status.

It is the EXHIBITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY to request measurement. If you dog does not have a valid height card for a trial and is not measured by a VMO, if present, any qualifying runs earned will be disallowed.

There will be VMOs at the trial.

AKC Registration information is required for completion of the official height card request form.

ACCOMMODATIONS

We strongly urge all exhibitors to make their overnight accommodation plans early! Some restrictions may apply. Please check with the hotel/motel regarding their dog policies. All dogs should not be left unattended. Clean-up on all property!

ALL OWNERS/EXHIBITORS SHOULD BE AWARE THAT THE ENTIRE MOTEL AND GROUNDS ARE CONSIDERED WITHIN THE TRIAL LIMITS. Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial or *back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at stand alone all-breed AKC agility trials. A stand alone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776.
