PLEASE NOTE: Rally and Obedience are separate trials. Entry of a dog in one class in Obedience and one class in Rally will cost \$48.00. (Two First Entries). In addition, DMOTC will add an \$25.00 fee to the amount for any returned checks.

Obedience classes that use jumps will be run in descending jump height order, beginning with dogs jumping 16". Rally classes that use jumps will be run in ascending jump height order, beginning with dogs jumping 12". **Entries without jump heights will not be accepted.**

Make checks payable to DMOTC. All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entries without the AKC agreement attached are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial. (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4) Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted.

Attention Exhibitors

The show site will be available to exhibitors one hour before the start of judging each day. The building will be closed and dogs must be removed from the show site each day within 30 minutes of the completion of judging.

Please leave the motel and motel grounds clean. Any complaints from proprietors will be handled by the Show Committee.

Telephone, email and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Make all checks and money orders payable to Des Moines Obedience Training Club. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries.

Mail all entries to Polly S. Mumma, PO Box 31094, Des Moines, IA 50310. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Unless an exhibitor specifically requests postal communication, submission of an email address on the entry form will serve as authorization to send communication, including entry confirmation via email. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that their email software will accept messages from polly@springertigger.com

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee or AKC. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance, and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

DMOTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these events.

Owners are responsible for errors on completed entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing, by telegram or email prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Post-dated and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$25 fee will be added to the amount of each returned check.

No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates, however, if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

Class prizes will be distributed in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims must be made in the ring before the judging for that show is over, and the Secretary advised at once. All prizes must be claimed at the show. If not, they become the property of DMOTC. No prizes will be mailed.

DMOTC reserves the right to substitute prizes with ones of equal or greater value.

DMOTC, the show secretary, members of the show committee, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, handlers, their employees or children, etc. or to any of their dogs or property. Entrants and spectators to this show do so entirely at their own risk.

This show is governed by The American Kennel Club. Exhibitors should read the AKC agreement on the entry blank in the premium list.

MOVE-UPS... WILL BE ACCEPTED AT THESE TRIALS, according to the provisions stated in "American Kennel Club, Obedience Regulations," Amended to June 1, 2005, Chapter 1, Section 16.

ALL DOGS MUST be on leash or kenneled unless showing in the ring.

DES MOINES OBEDIENCE TRAINING CLUB (DMOTC) may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against DMOTC or any official thereof.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trials cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. DMOTC reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

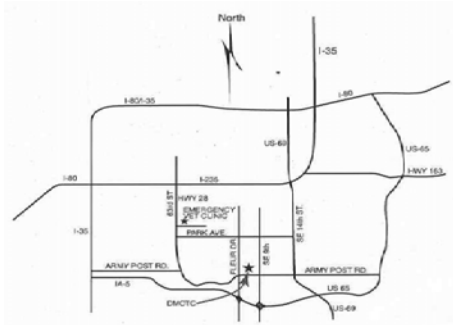

One half of an exhibitor's entry fees will be refunded for bitches that come into season after the closing date, as long as the trial secretary is provided documentation from a veterinarian at least 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the day's judging.

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
