NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

EFFECTIVE FOR ALL EVENTS held on and after January 1, 2008, the American Kennel Club will collect a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 service fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, in all AKC licensed and member club events. The current 50 cent recording fee will continue to be collected. In accordance with AKC Rally regulations, the AKC will collect a \$3.00 per entry of dog Rally Event Service Fee. A show-giving club shall assume the responsibility of collecting all Recording Fees and Event Service Fees for AKC and forwarding them along with all other required event results within seven (7) days of the close of the event.

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 6 PM CST, WEDNESDAY, June 24, 2026 at the mailing address of the Trial Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Ch 11, Sec 6, of the Dog Show Rules. Move-ups will be accepted for these trials according to Ch 1, Sec 16, Obedience Regulations.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH FEES to M.A. Klein, Trial Secretary, PO Box 194, Mitchellville IA 50169. Confirmation of entries will be made by email as soon as possible after entries have closed. MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS payable to CENTRAL IOWA DACHSHUND CLUB (CIBC.) Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, TELEPHONED, TELEGRAPHED OR FAXED ENTRIES cannot be accepted. Entries received without fees are not acceptable. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$35.00 fee will be added to all insufficient funds checks.

ENTRIES MUST BE ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS. Entries or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE TRIAL only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging. No refund for bitches in season. No unentered dogs allowed.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. **ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on short leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

LOSS OR DAMAGE - The Trial Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will **not be responsible for**, or assume any liability in the event of any accident or misfortune, to either dogs or exhibitors participating in these events. The welfare of an Exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the Exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

SEATING AND CRATING SPACE is limited. Crates must be stackable. Please be respectful of others at the trial and make room for exhibitors. No exceptions. **ALL CRATES MUST BE PLACED ON CRATE MATS.**

PLEASE BE CAUTIOUS WHEN LEAVING ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES. The Central Iowa Dachshund Club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this show hereby waive any claim for damages against CIBC or its members for such removal.

EACH EXHIBITOR is responsible for cleaning up after his own dog(s) and demonstrating proper consideration for Des Moines Obedience Training Club and any lodging facilities associated with these events. Any action that reflects negatively on the future availability for use of any of these facilities WILL result in an event committee hearing.

CIBC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the official AKC entry form for these events.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog to be judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC-approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself, (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents or other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); beagles (not exceeding 13 inches, over 13 inches but not exceeding 15 inches); dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired); bull terriers (colored, white); Manchester terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); English toy spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles); poodles (toy, miniature, standard), and collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (for complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
